

CONSTITUTION

NAVAL ASSOCIATION OF CANADA - VANCOUVER ISLAND

1. The name of the Society shall be the “Naval Association of Canada - Vancouver Island”.
2. The purpose of the Society is to:
 - a. Support the goals of the Naval Association of Canada (NAC);
 - (1) Educate the Canadian public to the requirement for a navy,
 - (2) Cooperate with organizations having similar objectives as the Naval Association of Canada, specifically to support the Navy League of Canada,
 - (3) Preserve Canada’s maritime heritage.
 - b. Undertake activities in support of the good of the community, either independently or in cooperation with the NAC, as approved by the membership;
 - c. Encourage maritime-minded youth in their development and education; in particular the local Sea Cadet and Navy League Cadet programmes.
 - d. Continue the camaraderie with the Royal Canadian Navy and its associations;
 - e. Provide guidance for the well being of all NAC VI members, particularly those who are sick, disabled, or in need.
